

McMinnville Transportation Bond OR 99W at 2nd Street Signal Replacement Project



2nd Street Construction Coming Soon!

When: June 2017 – October 2017 | **Where:** 2nd St from Adams St to Cowsls St

What are the construction impacts?

Road users should expect increased congestion, intermittent flagging, and delays in the project area - day and night. Please travel safely and follow construction signs. Daytime lane closures may occur on 2nd Street from 8:30 am to 3:30 pm on weekdays. Daytime lane closures may occur on Adams and Baker Streets from 9 am to 11:30 am and from 1pm to 3:30 pm on weekdays. All other lane closures will be at night. In addition:

- **Pedestrians:** There will be short-term sidewalk closures. A signed ADA-accessible pedestrian detour will be provided. Pedestrian circulation around the construction work zones will be provided at all times.
- **Bike Riders:** The shoulder and bike lanes will be closed throughout construction and signs will direct bicycle riders to use the motor vehicle travel lanes.
- **Business Access:** There will be unavoidable short-term driveway closures, including business parking lot stall closures. The City will work individually with each business to schedule the closures and ensure business access.
- **Detours:** 2nd Street will be closed to westbound traffic during construction work shifts. A signed temporary vehicle detour will be installed to head North from 2nd Street on Baker Street (or Davis Street) to 5th Street, Adams Street, and back to 2nd Street.



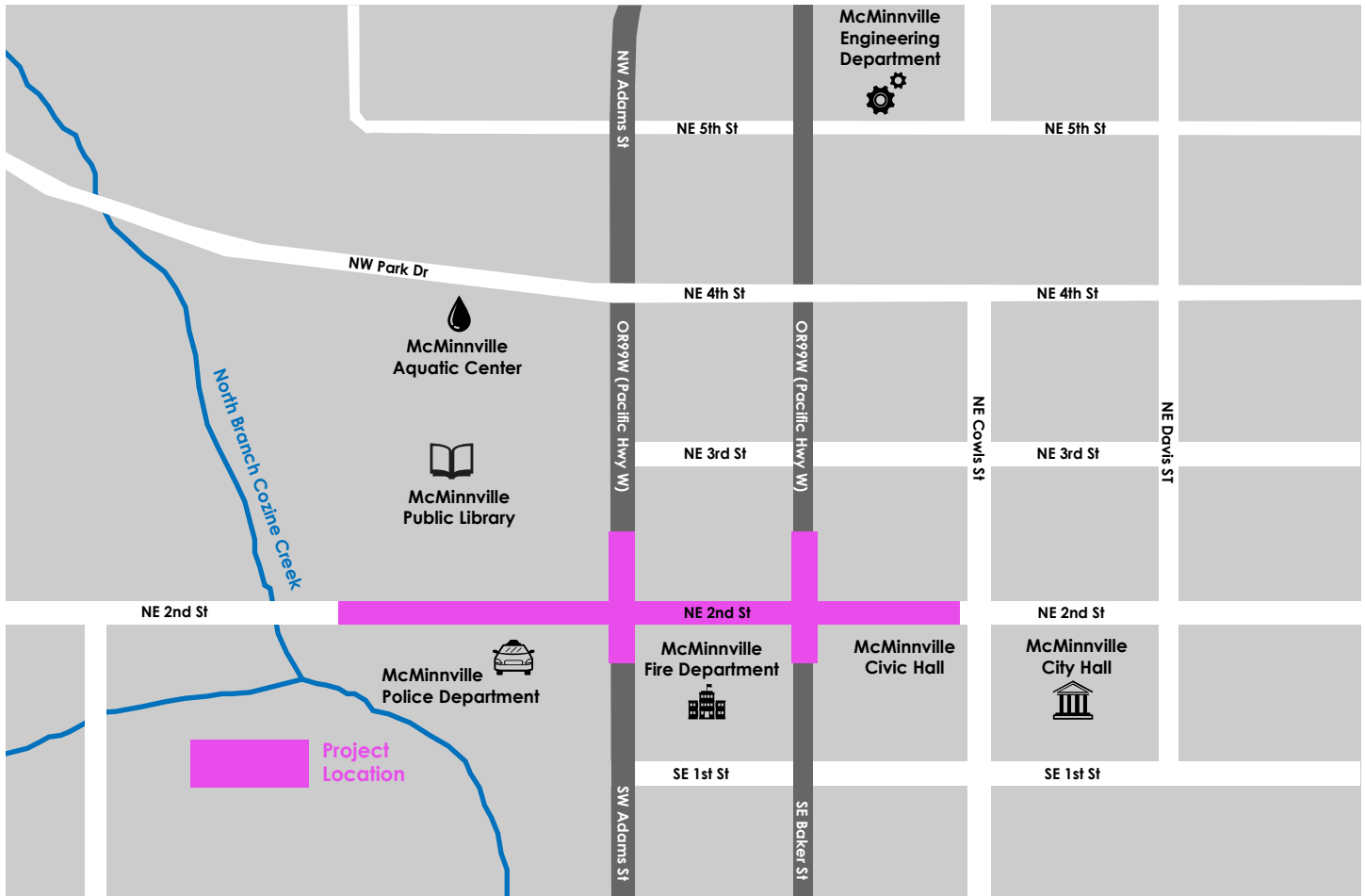

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What are the main project improvements?

- Widen 2nd Street to construct side-by-side left turn lanes between Adams and Baker Streets to increase capacity through the intersections.
- Install a westbound to northbound right turn slip lane on 2nd Street, at Baker Street, to provide a refuge for right turning vehicles, allowing westbound thru traffic to flow uninterrupted on 2nd Street.
- Install new LED street lights, which will help pedestrians see and be seen better.
- Install pedestrian countdown signals so pedestrians will have more accurate information when crossing.
- Construct curb ramps to improve pedestrian access and be compliant with the Americans with Disabilities Act (ADA).
- Sanitary sewer rehabilitation within the project vicinity to repair aging sewer facilities.
